

# Pharmacy Drawer Options

OmniceLL offers a wide variety of drawer options for storing, controlling, and accurately tracking the use of medications and pharmacy supplies. Pharmacy drawers integrate into the Omnicell OmniRx® automated dispensing cabinet product family and Anesthesia Workstation™ to create customized systems for specific clinical needs.

## Modular Drawer Configurations

OmniceLL pharmacy drawer modules can be configured in a variety of ways within Omnicell automated dispensing cabinets. The OmniRx cabinet can accommodate up to 13 drawers, while the OmniTT™ tabletop cabinet can accommodate three pharmacy drawers.

Each cell of the OmniRx one-cell, two-cell, and three-cell cabinets can fit a three-drawer pharmacy module, a nine-drawer pharmacy module, or an OmniDispenser™ module (with or without pharmacy drawers). The pharmacy drawer modules can be placed in the middle and/or lower zone of the cell, to provide maximum flexibility in configuring the cabinet to meet the specific needs of a nursing area.

## OmniDispenser Single-Dose Dispensing System

The OmniDispenser stores medications in a separate, secured location in the cabinet and dispenses each dose individually, so nurses only have access to the specific quantities requested. The system automatically tracks every dose, eliminating time-consuming count-backs to confirm remaining inventories of controlled substances. This is a significant time saver for nurses that gives them more time for patient care.

### Key Features

- Eliminates the need to confirm remaining inventories of controlled substances (i.e. no count-backs), greatly reducing discrepancies.
- Push-button technology helps ensure accurate restocks.
- Security facilitates improved compliance with The Joint Commission and other regulatory standards.

### Guiding Lights

OmniceLL's unique guiding lights technology visually directs clinicians to the drawer and then to the appropriate bin within the drawer for the medication they had selected. This feature reduces the possibility of nurses taking the wrong item.

## FlexBin™ Single-Dose Drawer

The FlexBin single-dose drawer provides a high level of security for medications. With this drawer, access to a medication is restricted to the item and quantity chosen by the clinician. No other doses are available.

There is no need to confirm the remaining quantity or conduct end-of-shift counts, which results in fewer discrepancies.

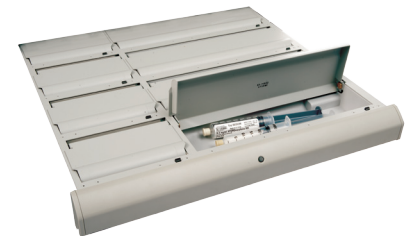


### Key Features

## Locking Lid Drawer

Locking bins, suitable for controlled substances, provide a high level of security by restricting access to one preselected medication at a time. An audio alarm sounds if a clinician attempts to access a non-preselected compartment and notification is recorded and sent to pharmacy. The tamper-proof metal lids of each bin further ensure security.

### Sensing Lid Drawer

Sensing bins, with see-through lids, provide a medium level of control. Special sensors on the bin lids detect bin entry and provide audible and visual feedback to clinicians attempting to open bins for items that have not been preselected. Any unauthorized entry attempts are recorded in the system, thus providing deterrence to inappropriate activity.

### Lighted Matrix Drawer

The Lighted Matrix Drawer provides a lower level of security but maximum flexibility. Lights frame the bin and guide the user to the preselected medication, reducing the possibility of errors.

### Matrix Drawer

The Matrix Drawer is a high-capacity, low security drawer that is suitable for large quantities of non-controlled medications. The Double-Deep Matrix Drawer accommodates large quantities of medication or larger items such as large vials and premixed IV bags.

### Omnicell Medication/Supply Drawer
